RENTAL TRACKING module

Many store owners need to include a simple control module for items they rent to customers as in the case of convenience stores and grocery stores that rent movie video cassettes or DVD's.

The L-POS rental module is an optional addition that can save manual paperwork and speed up the check-out process where rental items need to be tracked.

System features include:

- The system allows you to define 2 different types of rental items. These are typically the films themselves and the machines rented to customers to play the game or watch the movie being rented.
- Film rentals are controlled by 24 hour periods. The system knows anything that leaves today needs to be back tomorrow by the return time even though we specified a 24 hour period.
- Machine rental periods can be programmed to offer a selection when the item is rented. So day rental, week-end rental, weekly rental or others can be defined.
- Control of late returns with the possibility of automatically charging a fee to the customer account.
- L-POS can print a special text message whenever a film is rented to ensure the customer agrees to the rental conditions.
- Reports can be printed to list films that are out and late returns. This helps when you want to track down missing films.
- The system reports on who rented which item. This means that when films come back damaged you can search to find who had the film last.
- You can associate multiple copies of the same product. This means you know immediately if a title is available when someone enquires.
- The rental option in L-POS and L-BOSS is ideal for a retail store that rents items, but where the item rental is really a secondary business to the core business of selling products. By integrating the rental within one system, L-POS simplifies the check-out process and the maintenance of data.

L-BOSS, L-POS and the Accounts Receivable module are required to use this optional module.
